**REOPENING GUIDE FOR EATING & DRINKING PLACES**

- SANITIZATION**  
1) use plexiglass shields on counters, 2) install temporary walls to direct movement, 3) provide lots of handwashing stations and hand sanitizer, 4) use signage for customers to stay distant apart, 5) clean door handles often, and 6) mark floors to guide traffic flow.
- PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT (PPE)**  
1) use branded or colorful masks for staff & guests, 2) check staff temperature daily, 3) provide face shields for food preparers, 4) use aprons for all staff, 5) encourage wearing of gloves when appropriate, and 6) train staff on PPE only.
- RETHINK MENU & UTENSILS**  
1) use disposable printed menus, 2) create wall menus inside & outside, 3) use a sidewalk menu board, 4) consider putting a menu on your Facebook page (NEKC Chamber can help you), 5) sanitize utensils & package in paper, and 6) consider single-serve condiments.
- REARRANGE SPACE**  
1) use floor & wall markings and physical items for 10-foot spacing of tables & 6-foot spacing from back-of-chair to back-of-chair, 2) create limited seating in your inside waiting areas, 3) provide for one-way entrances & exits, and 4) adjust supply orders to fit inventory into smaller spaces.
- ADVISE & GUIDE CUSTOMERS**  
1) consider asking customers to your Facebook and website for ordering ahead, 2) encourage using no-touch phone payment & paying with a charge card instead of cash, and 3) gently ask patrons to wait outside OR in vehicles—following necessary seating and spacing guidelines.
- STAY INFORMED & INFORM**  
1) be alert to state & local updates, 2) partner with other local businesses & organizations like NEKC Chamber: <http://www.necchamber.com>, 3) use networking groups like MO Restaurant Association: <http://www.mo-restaurant-association.com>, and 4) use signage and word-of-mouth to inform staff & guests of health safety habits (see above websites for additional information).

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into this 1st day of May 1, 2020 between KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, a constitutionally chartered municipal corporation (City), and NORTHEAST KANSAS CITY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE ("CONTRACTOR"). Whereby Contractor shall provide services, PART I. SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS, and PART II. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS to the City in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in this contract.

## PART I SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**Sec. 1. Purpose.** As a part of the Choice Neighborhoods Implementation Program, the City of Kansas City, MO has established a Commercial Façade Improvement Program that will assist eligible owners of commercial property and businesses in the Paseo Gateway neighborhoods to make exterior improvements to their property. The specific purpose of this Contract and the Project Area is attached as **Attachment 1**, and is incorporated herein by reference.

**Sec. 2. Term of Contract.** This Contract shall begin on May 1, 2020 and shall end no later than September 30, 2022. The Director is authorized to enter into an amendment to extend the term of this Contract and time of performance for this Contract.

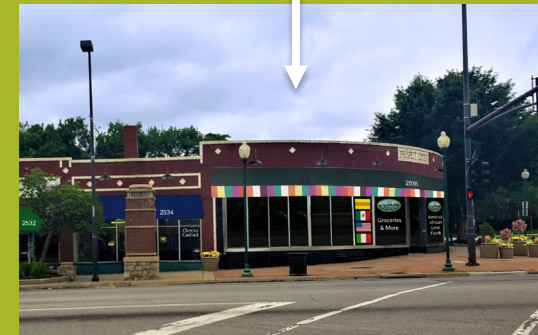
## Sec. 3. Maximum Compensation and Total Obligation.

**A. Maximum Compensation.** The maximum amount that City can pay Contractor and the total obligation which may accrue to the City under this Contract is **TWO HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$220,000)**, pursuant to the budget approved by City. The execution and implementation of this Contract shall not create a general charge upon the General Revenues of the City, as envisioned by Section 82 of the Charter of Kansas City, Missouri. Any financial obligation is dependent upon the availability of funds under the line of credit issued to the Housing Authority of Kansas City by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to Grant No. MO7A002CNG114. No financial obligation shall accrue against the City unless such order bears the written statement of the City's Director of Finance that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to credit of City under the above described line of credit from which payment is to be made.

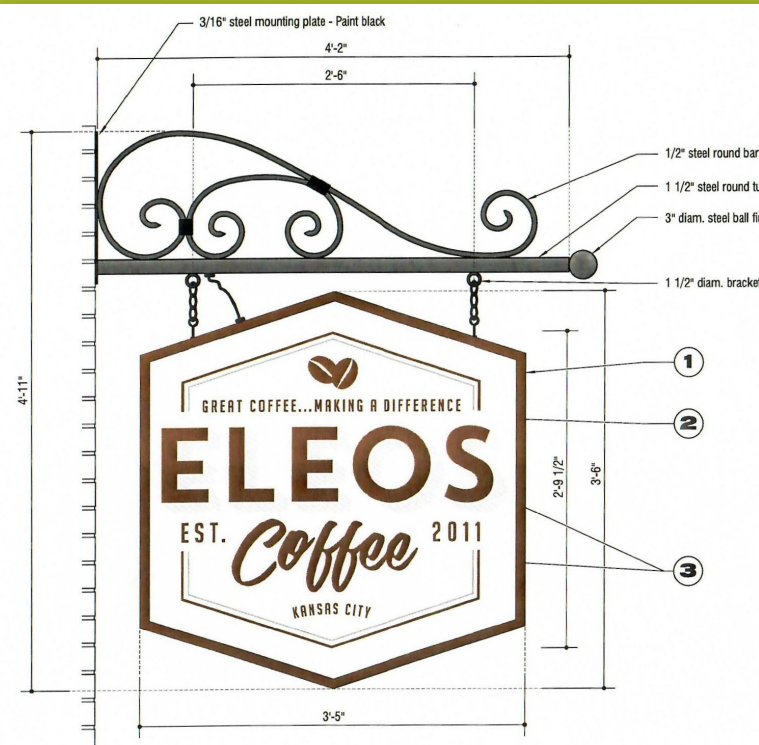
