#### CONTRACT NO. EV2788 CHOICE NEIGHBORHOODS COMMERCIAL FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into this 1st day of May 1, 2020 between KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, a constitutionally chartered municipal corporation (City), and NORTHEAST KANSAS CITY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (CONTRACTOR'). Whereby Contractor shall provide services, PART I, SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS, and PART II, GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS to the City in accordance with the contained in this contract

#### PART I SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Sec. 1. Purpose. As a part of the Choice Neighborhoods Implementation Program, the City of Kanasa City, MO has established a Commercial Façade Improvement Program that will assist eligible owners of commercial property and businesses in the Pasco Gateway neighborhoods to make exterior improvements to their property. The specific purpose of this Contract and the Project Area is in statched as Attachment 1, and in incorporated herein by

Sec. 2. Term of Contract. This Contract shall begin on May 1, 2020 and shall end no later than September 30, 2022. The Director is authorized to <u>entre</u> into a mendment to extend the term of this Contract and time of performance for this Contract.

#### Sec. 3. Maximum Compensation and Total Obligation

A. Maximum Compensation. The maximum amount that City can pay Contractor and the total obligation which may accrue to the City under this Contract is TWO HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$22.0006), pursuant to the budget approved by City. General Revenues of the City, as envisioned by Section \$2.0 fthe Charter of Kansas City, Missouri. Any financial obligation is dependent upon the availability of funda under the line of credit issued to the Housing Authority of Kansas City by the Under States Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to Grant No. MOTAOO2CNG114. No financial obligation shall accrue against the City unless such order bears the written statement of the under the above described line of credit flow which nawment in to be made. the above described line of credit from which payment is to be made

## MYRTLE – CLEVELAND (GRINGO LOCO) South of Independence Ave






