ABOUT BLOOD

Blood can be split into different components which are then used for different medical purposes.

55% PLASMA
It is a yellow liquid that makes up about 55% of the body's blood volume. Used on trauma victims and in medical emergencies.

3% WHITE BLOOD CELLS
Part of the body's immune system, detect and fight viruses and bacteria. Makes up about 3% of body's blood volume.

1% PLATELETS
Form clots to stop bleeding. Makes up less than 1% of body's blood volume. Commonly used to treat cancer patients and trauma victims.

41% RED BLOOD CELLS
Carry fresh oxygen through the body and remove carbon dioxide. Make up about 40-45% of body's blood volume and used to treat anemia, sickle cell disease, trauma victims, etc.

ABOUT BLOOD DONATION

THE 4-STEP DONATION PROCESS

STEP 1
Registration: collection of basic personal info. Must have photo ID.

STEP 2
Medical History: answer series of questions about your past medical history then undergo a mini-physical with our staff members.

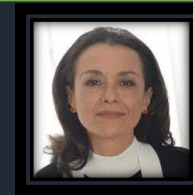
STEP 3
Donation: the actual process of donating whole blood takes about 10 minutes.

STEP 4
Refreshment: sit and enjoy snacks and beverages for about 10-15 minutes after your donation is completed

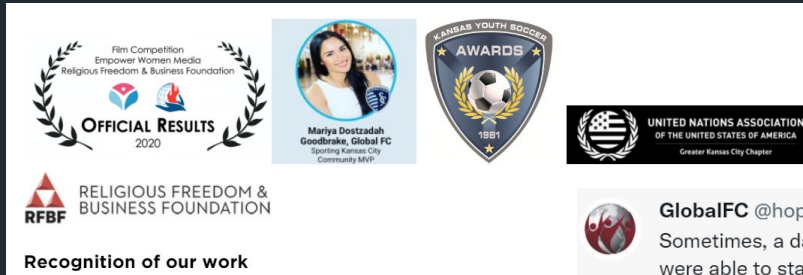
Global FC has partnered with the Northeast Kansas City Chamber of Commerce this summer to host tutoring at the Economic Growth Gallery (EGG) at 2659 Independence Ave.

Global FC is a local nonprofit organization that uses soccer as a medium for transformative impact that also helps kids with their academics. The program first started helping refugee kids get the education and support they needed during the 2014 refugee crisis.

"There was just a group of people who were like, 'Well there's a lot of protesting, debate, happening but not a lot of action, so what's something that we can actually do to help the refugee community,'" said Celeste Williams, Director of Coaching for Global FC. "They found that soccer was a meaningful and relevant tool for connecting with kids."

Global FC's main focus is on English development and making sure kids are learning the language.

"A lot of our focus is on literacy development, reading, writing, and sometimes spoken English," Williams said. "We also know that as refugees, a lot of our kids have either had poor prior schooling or interrupted schooling."

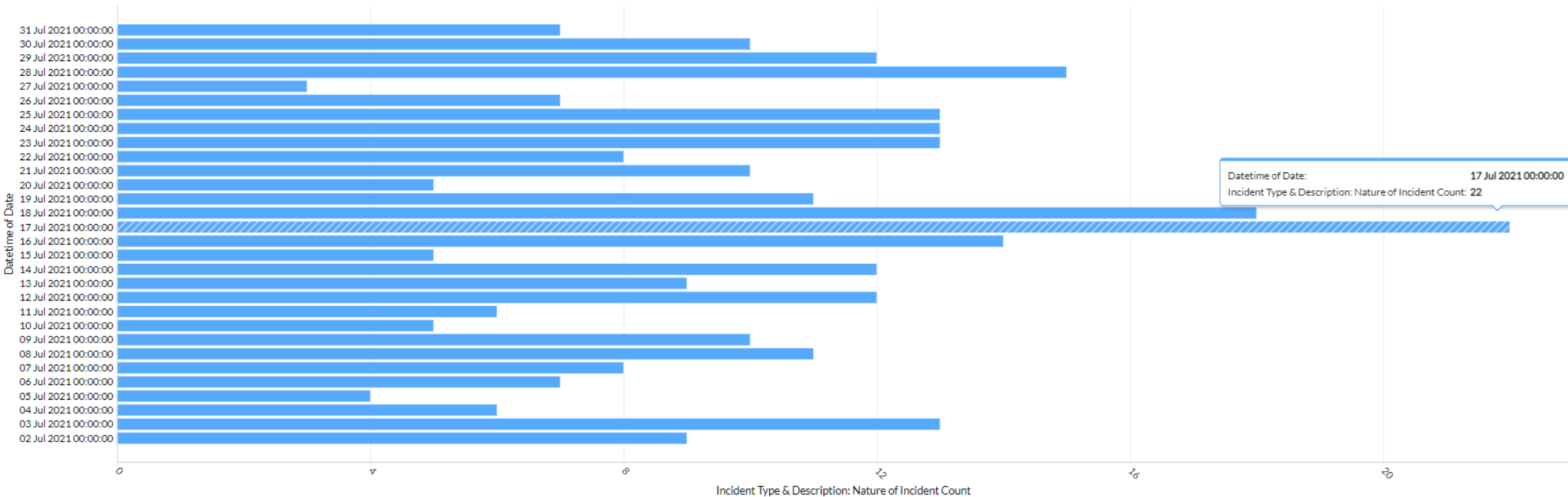

Black lime, or dried lime, adds a certain zing to Arabic dishes, giving them a distinct flavor. They are usually sold in large quantities, but Huda Food will sell them in small quantities to those who are interested in trying them.
