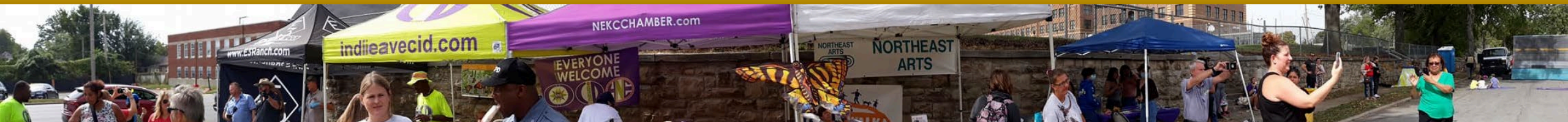

Longtime Northeast resident celebrates new citizenship

The Northeast News extends our congratulations to one of Historic Northeast's newest American citizens, Rol Deng. The Business Development Representative for the Northeast Chamber of Commerce was sworn in as a United States citizen last Wednesday, Dec. 8.

Deng immigrated to the United States 21 years ago from Egypt, but is originally from Aweil, Sudan. He settled here in Historic Northeast with his family, where he worked tirelessly to send his children to college.

Now, he is working on his Bachelor of Applied Science in Business Management at Northwest Missouri State University and works full-time for the Northeast Chamber and the Independence Avenue Community Improvement District. On taking the oath to become a U.S. citizen, he says he's very proud.

"I am very proud, I have a lot of opportunities as a United States citizen and in the community, as well," Deng said. "So it is really a great achievement for me to be a citizen today."

The first thing Deng will do with his new citizenship is return to his home country to visit his mother, who is 88. He plans to surprise her by sitting down and holding her hand, something he hasn't done in over two decades.

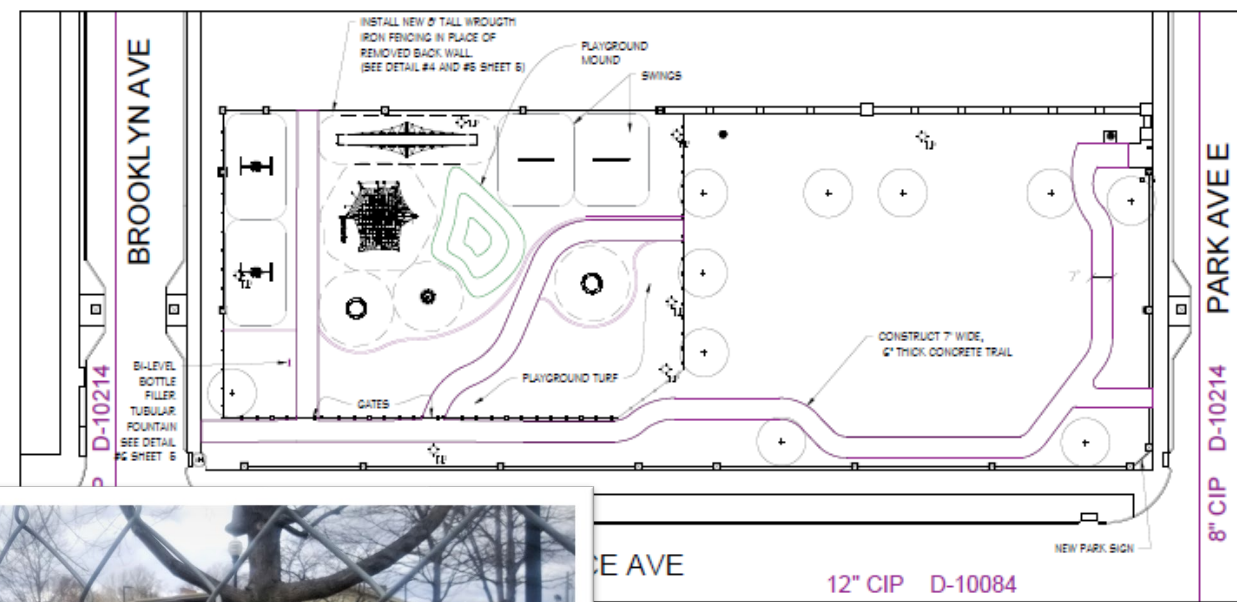


# City breaks ground on Independence Plaza Park upgrades

A transformative project will soon bring new life to a park in the city's Historic Northeast neighborhood. City leaders on Monday morning broke ground on upgrades to Independence Plaza Park - part of several improvements being funded by a \$30 million grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Park upgrades will include:

- A new, attractive universally accessible playground for children regardless of their degree of mobility
- An active gathering/programmable space for families
- A futsal court and walking trail on the South side
- Fencing, LED lighting enhancements, and signage improvements for both the north and south side of the park.
